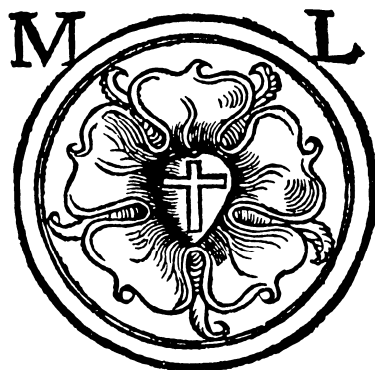

What is confession?
